I. The Early Persians



- The Persians were a nomadic group from Central Asia & expert horsemen
- <u>Cyrus the Great (r. 559-529 BCE)</u> united the Persian tribes and conquered vast lands including Egypt and Mesopotamia
- The Persians didn't have urban traditions but their culture was an amalgamation of Egyptian, Babylonian, Assyrian & Greek cultures



III. Darius I and the Bureaucracy



- <u>Darius I (</u>r. 521-486) continued to expand the borders of his empire
- The bureaucracy used the local traditions of the people instead of forcing Persian traditions
- Persians believed that all subjects were equal: they all needed to give the king their loyalty and pay tribute
- Trade was promoted by establishing roads and introducing standard weights and measures
